



## Special Call for Consultants

### ***Consultancy: Genesys website revision***

The Global Crop Diversity Trust (<https://www.croptrust.org/>) is an international organization with Headquarters in Bonn, Germany whose mission is to ensure the conservation and availability of crop diversity for food security worldwide.

The Crop Trust develops and maintains databases and associated software that support the work of world's genebanks, specifically Genesys, the global database of information on plant genetic material maintained in world's genebanks at <https://www.genesys-pgr.org>, GG-CE, a genebank collection management database, and a number of smaller web-based utilities.

The products are in continuous development which occasionally results in inconsistent user interfaces. The selected consultant will provide support in maintaining consistent, user-friendly, modern user interface (UI) and user experience (UX) design of our products, including:

- A revision of the general layout of the existing website (navigation, color scheme) and navigation.
- Revision of the websites for improved Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) and Accessible Rich Internet Applications (WAI-ARIA) compliance.
- Development of the look and feel of individual website components, including prototyping with wireframes.
- Templates for printed materials (Word templates) and newsletter HTML code.

The consultant will release all intellectual property produced under this contract to the Crop Trust. Outputs will be primarily graphics (in PNG, PDF or PSD format), but can also be CSS, HTML or direct contributions to the source code. The consultant will submit the outputs to the repository provided by the Crop Trust. Outputs and communications on the Crop Trust issue tracker may be publicly accessible.

Interested candidates are asked to send a recent CV and a detailed cover letter outlining your qualifications to [trustvacancy@croptrust.org](mailto:trustvacancy@croptrust.org) with the subject line "Genesys website revision" as soon as possible as, however, **no later than 21 May 2021**. The cover letter should indicate the suggested daily fees in EUR, as well as a description of previous relevant experience.
